# Harold's Letter

## TIME

In Shakespeare's "Macbeth", a disconsolate Macbeth mourns his late wife and says... "She should have died hereafter.....tomorrow and tomorrow and tomorrow creeps in this petty pace from day to day to the last syllable of recorded time and all our yesterdays have lighted fools the way to dusty death." A very sombre way of looking at life! As one French philosopher once said, "All men are born; all men suffer; all men die". We are not immortal.

But it expresses the progress and the continuity of chronological time. Nothing stops chronological time. Our year begins on 1st January; progresses through the twelve months of Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter and ends of the 31st December. Then it starts all over again! Other than Dr Who, we have not yet found the secret of moving forward or backward in time!

It's the same with the Church Calendar. This begins with Advent Sunday; continues through Christmas and Epiphany; Ash Wednesday ushers in Lent;

then comes Holy Week, Good Friday and Easter Day; Ascension Day and Pentecost; the interminable Sundays after Trinity; and the Church Calendar ends with Christ the King Sunday. Then it starts all over again!

One Greek word for time is Chronos, as in chronological! The other New Testament word for time is Kairos, which means God's time. The time in God's Kingdom is not expressed in chronology, nor in life and death. God rules over both life and death. For us as Christians, we believe and trust that through the life, death and resurrection of God's Son, Jesus Christ, our sins are forgiven and we are at peace with God both here and now in this

life and, after we die, in Heaven. Our God reigns OK! Our Christian life is eternal.

This Advent we prepare ourselves to celebrate the birth of Jesus to Mary and Joseph over 2,000 years ago in Bethlehem. Every Christmas is a birthday party for Jesus! One family set an extra place at their table on Christmas Day for Emmanuel, also known as Jesus! Emmanuel means God is with us!

We very much hope that by Christmas Day all the work on Christ Church's roofs will be finished and we will be able to celebrate this Christmas in our warm, dry church, with no raindrops falling on our heads. Our main service this Christmas is our 8pm First Communion of Christmas on 24th December, Christmas Eve. Do come and join us. You will be very welcome.

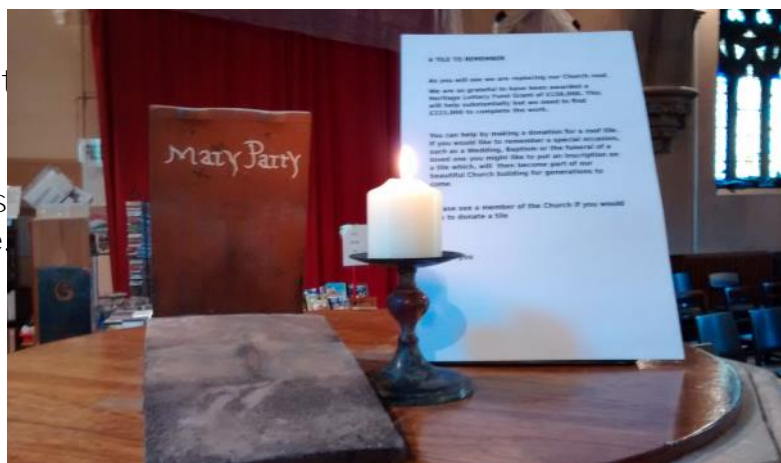

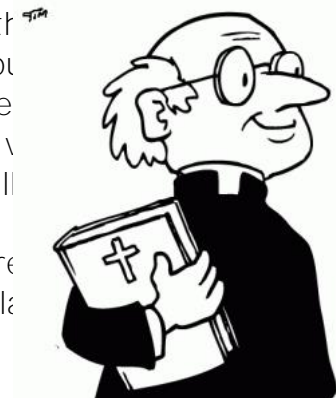
